

Winkhaus multipoint locks are popular with timber door manufacturers as they have one of the widest range of locking options available.

Keeps and locks are often handed depending on the handing of the door which can often mean holding stock of both types in order to be prepared for upcoming jobs.

The Winkhaus Thunderbolt lock removes this problem as it is reversible, thanks in part to the twin chamfered profile of the deadbolts.

You will notice if it is not supplied in the handing you require as the latch striker will be facing the wrong way. To reverse it, simply:

1. Push the latch striker in and undo the screw at the back.
2. Reverse the latch striker's orientation.
3. Push the latch striker in and tighten the screw.
